

Spray gun cleaning procedure

Nozzle set disassembling



Firstly remove paint needle



Followed by the air cap



Unscrew fluid tip

Cleaning and Drying



Clean the material passage



Clean the spray gun body



Dry with blow gun

When cleaning the spray gun manually, please ensure not to use brushes made of metal wires which could possibly damage the spray gun. Furthermore, please make sure that no cleaning fluid ends up in the air passages of the spray gun body.

Nozzle set cleaning

When cleaning the nozzle components, please make sure that metal parts of brushes do not damage the nozzle set. Ideally, please use specially designed SAGOLA cleaning brushes and SAGOLA nozzle cleaning needles to ensure optimum cleaning and maintenance of the nozzle set.

This ensures free movement and perfect function of the components, even after many years of use.
